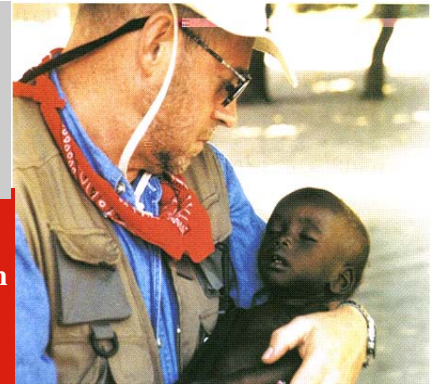


A Message From Our Director

We are pleased to announce that Josh Grill will join our staff as our Family 2 Family Project Coordinator beginning the last week of June in 2008. Josh and his wife Amy have 3 children and live in Winona Lake, In. Josh is a graduate of Grace College and has a masters from Ball State University. Josh and Amy traveled to Honduras with us the past 2 years. This summer he was a co-leader for week 3. Tax Deductible Giving and Receipts

2007 1040s will soon be due

We are near the end of 2007 and it will soon be time to pay the taxes. If your gift is received by December 31, 2007 you will be able to deduct the gift from your taxes this year. This includes stocks, bonds, Gift In Kind (GIK), gifts of tangible items like food, clothes, vehicles, and other items that can be used by the ministry. In the case of GIK, you must declare the value of the gift in writing. We can then issue a receipt for the amount declared by you. You might also consider WCN in your estate planning. It is possible to name WCN as the beneficiary of a life insurance policy. We issue receipts monthly as the gifts are received. As stated on your receipts, in order to save on postage and other mailing costs, we do not send year end giving reports. If you forgot to save your receipts, we will send one upon receiving a written request. We thank you for partnering with us in bringing the gospel through **Compassion Ministry**.
